2025 in Review

Early this year we hired Mike Ansel, Jr. to be our new Caretaker. Please introduce yourself if you see him out by his trailer working on his Harley or Ford.

Membership and income have held steady, but as you know, everything costs more now. Hopefully our new tax-exempt status will benefit us with our taxes. We need all members to actively participate in our fund-raising activities to hold dues at the current rate.

Once again, our property needed no major repairs. Last year Adams Electric Coop installed poles so we could run electricity to the rifle range. Wiring was recently run, a panel box was installed, and the project will be completed by the time you read this. The 100-yard target at the rifle range was completely rebuilt and many trees alongside the range were trimmed. We did make a major purchase of a new riding mower for \$13K as our old one was falling apart and we continue to plan for other major needs including a new tractor, clubhouse roof & parking lot paving.

Streambank erosion near the pistol range is still a major concern. We were not approved for grant money again this year but remember this is a 3–5-year process due to government funding procedures.
